Sisal:

Sisal is produced from fibers extracted from the agave plants' long spiny leaves, which are harvested as an annual crop. Renowned for their strength, these long white fibers are sun-dried and then carefully spun into fine carpet yarn.

Application: As a natural floor covering, sisal is versatile for use indoors in climate-controlled environments. It performs beautifully as a wall-to-wall "hard surface" backdrop for most decorating styles, or as a custom cut area rug. It is not recommended for use outdoors.

Installation:

For wall-to-wall fitting, we recommend either direct glue-down or commercial double-stick installation. Full installation guidelines are available from your local representative.

Fiber Characteristics:

Because sisal is made entirely of natural plant fibers, it reflects the irregularity found in nature. A perfectly uniform floor covering is not possible using natural sisal fibers. Weaving variations- including knots, slubs, lines and color variances- are inherent and desirable property of sisal floor coverings.
